Prologue / Initiation

The topic of aging of the female pelvic floor is receiving much attention lately as a public health priority because of the global increase in female life expectancy and the significant risk of associated pelvic floor dysfunctions.

Prof. Rizk will give us insights about the pathogenesis of this life-limiting and prevalent condition and the interaction between hormonal and degenerative changes that are influenced/caused by both menopause and aging on the pelvic floor and their possible consequences like urinary incontinence, pelvic organ prolapse and fecal incontinence based on his animal experiments.

In the second part, Prof. Rizk will talk about Ethics of biomedical publishing, that reviews the ethical guidelines of scientific publications for authors, editors, publishers and readers from different academic disciplines.

Publication ethics also provides an overview of ethical research practices and how to deal with publication misconduct.
